Ever Cat brings new process online

Ever Cat Fuels LLC announced its plant in Isanti, Minn., is officially in operation as of Sept. 11. "We believe this is a major step towards energy independence in the United States," said Clayton McNeff, chief science officer. "This commencement of plant operations on Sept. 11, eight years after the horrific attacks on America perpetrated by terrorists, is especially meaningful as we honor those whom were lost on that dark day in history.

The opening of the 3 MMgy plant marks the commercialization of a new biodiesel technology dubbed the Mcgyan process after its founders. Using no water or chemicals and producing no waste products, the conversion takes seconds in two reactors that are 6 feet tall by 6 inches in diameter.

A grand opening is scheduled for Sept. 28. In its announcement, Ever Cat Fuels said it plans to further expand the facility to 33 MMgy in the next three years.
